

**Mission Examination 2019-20**  
**Instructions for students**

- Every student should have Smartphone/Laptop/ Tab/Desktop with internet connection.
- Students should ensure that their Smartphones/Laptops/Tabs are fully charged at the time of examination.
- Students can connect the internet of Smartphone to the Laptop through/via hotspot if they want to. Students have to keep their Web Cams 'ON' during the examination.
- If any problem related with Smartphone/Laptop/Tab/Desktop or internet connectivity arises during the examination, students are advised not to get panicky and immediately contact the College Help Desk or their teachers or any other teacher from the College by using other phone.
- There will be Twenty Five (25) for 50 marks..2 marks each. Similarly there will be multiple Choice Questions (MCQs) with four options of answer such as A, B, C, D or a, b, c, d. Students have to choose the correct option of answer.
- The duration of Examination will be one hour.
- The Link of the examination will be sent one day prior to your registered e-mail ID. The link will be activated only 10 minutes before the commencement of examinations (e.g. if the paper is at 10.00 a.m. then link will be activated at 9.50 a.m. sharp )
- Students from PWD (Persons with Disabilities) categories will be entitled for extra Twenty Minutes (20) time per hour as per the guidelines issued by the University of Mumbai.
- Students from PWD category should submit the letter with necessary certificates through e-mail to their respective Colleges.
- Even though, the duration of examination is one hour, students are advised to submit their papers as soon as they complete answering all questions as there should not be any technical problem due to electricity failure or non-availability of internet.
- Regarding Model Questions and Time Table of Examination be in touch with your College or check the official website of your College.
- Students should refrain themselves from involving in any kind of unfair means. Action will be taken against those students who will found to be involved in unfair means during examination as per University rules and regulations.
- **There will NOT BE REVALUATION facility as this is the online examination.**
- **Students WILL NOT GET PHOTOCOPY of their answer-sheet/response sheet.**
- Students are advised to strictly follow the Examination Time Table and instructions given by their respective Colleges from time-to-time.
- Do not believe in rumours or forwarded messages on social media like Facebook, WhatsApp, Instagram, Telegram, etc.
- Students are advised to contact for any examination related query to the Help Desk of their respective Colleges.
