

UNDER GRADUATE PROGRAMME EXAMINATION PATTERN:

- The undergraduate programme of the college is of three years integrated pattern, divided into six semesters with two semesters at each year.
- Each semester of under graduate programme will have Internal Continuous Assessment, Semester End Examination and Practical Examination (B.Sc. Information Technology and B.Sc. Data Science).

Continuous Internal Evaluation (CIE) (20/40 marks) – 40 % weightage will be distributed as follows:

- CIEI: Test (10/20 marks)
- CIE II (Project/Presentation/Fieldwork/Review/Tutorials/Assignment etc.) (5/10 marks)
- CIE III Class participation/Attendance (5/10marks)

Semester End Examination (30/60 marks) -60% weightage

- Paper pattern as decided by respective Board of Studies
- Equal weightage to each module of the syllabus.

Practical Examination (50 marks) – 50% for B.Sc. Information Technology and B.Sc. Data Science.

Attendance Criteria

- Every student should have attended minimum of 75% of total class room teaching hours / practical per semester to be eligible for the Semester End / Continuous Assessment / Practical examination although 100% is the desired limit.
- However, the Principal has the authority to condone up to 25% of attendance in deserving cases but in no case such condonation should go below 50% of total attendance.
- If an under graduate student is unable to appear in the Semester End / Continuous Assessment / Practical examination due to medical reason, participation in sports or cultural activities, an additional examination will be conducted. To be eligible for additional examination a student has to apply before the starting of the semester examinations.
- If an under graduate student is disallowed to appear for Semester End / Continuous Assessment
 / Practical examination on the ground of shortage of attendance he or she may be allowed to appear for the same semester examination to be conducted subsequently at the end of the next semester.
- Eligibility to appear in the examination: All students having attended the prescribed number of days / hours of class room teaching / practical are eligible for the Semester End Examination/ Continuous Assessment / Practical Examinations.

Passing Criterion

40% (Combined passing in CIE, Semester End Examination and Practical Examination) subject to securing minimum 25 % in CIE.

Minimum credits:

14 credits in each semester to be eligible for admission in the next class

PASSING STANDARD (FOR TY Choice base pattern students)

Standard of Passing: The learner to pass a course shall have to obtain a minimum of 40% marks in aggregate for each course where the course consists of Internal Assessment & Semester End Examination. The learner shall obtain minimum of 40% marks (i.e. 16 out of 40) in the Internal Assessment and 40% marks in Semester End Examination (i.e. 24 out of 60) separately, to pass the course and minimum of Grade E in the project component, wherever applicable to pass a particular semester. A learner will be said to have passed the course if the learner passes the Internal Assessment & Semester End Examination together

Allowed to Keep Terms (ATKT): (FOR SY & TY Choice base pattern students)

- 1) A learner shall be allowed to keep term for Semester II, Notwithstanding, that he/ she may not
- 2) have appeared for Semester-I
- 3) OR irrespective of number of courses of failure in the semester I. 2) A learner shall be allowed to keep term for Semester III, Notwithstanding, that the learner may not have appeared for the Examinations of Semester-I & or Semester –II OR Irrespective of number of courses of failure in the Semester-I and/ or semester –II.
- 4) A learner shall be allowed to keep term for semester -IV, irrespective of number of courses of failure in the Semester- I and/ OR Semester -II, and OR Semester -III, A learner is allowed to appear for semester - IV Examination' but the result of semester-IV shall be kept in abeyance until the learner passes all courses of Semester - I, II, & III.

COLLEGE RULES & REGULATIONS GENERAL:

RULES FOR REFUND OF FEES

(Vide University circular no.UG/412 of 2008 dt.11th September, 2008)

0.2859 : Refund of Tuition, Development and all other fees after cancellation of admissions :

The candidates who have taken admission in undergraduate courses in Govt. colleges, in Govt. aided and unaided courses conducted by affiliated colleges, and recognized Institutions may request for refund of fees after applying in writing for cancellation of their admission to the course. The refund of fees as applicable shall be made on or before 30th day after the date of cancellation and thereafter by RTGS. The percentage of fee for the course shall be refunded to the candidate after deducting charges as follows :

NOTE:- The total amount considered for the refund of fees from the commencement of academic term of the courses includes the following :-

- 1) All the fee items chargeable for one year are as per relevant University circulars for different faculties (excluding the courses for which the total amount is fixed by other competent authorities.
- 2) The fee charged towards group insurance and all fee components to be paid as University share (including Vice- Chancellor fund, University fee for sports and cultural activities, E-charge, disaster management fund, Exam. fee and Enrolment fee) are non-refundable if payment is made by the college prior to the date of cancellation
- 3) Fee collected for Identity card and Library card, Admission form and prospectus, Enrollment and any other course specific fee **are not refundable**
- 4) All refundable deposits (Laboratory, Caution Money and Library etc.) **shall be fully returned** at the time of cancellation.
- 5) Provided that wherever admissions are made through centralized admission process for professional and / or for any other courses by other competent Authorities, the Refund Rules are applicable if specified by such authorities (as per the rules of relevant agencies) for the 1st year admission. In case of admission to subsequent years of the course, 0.2859 is applicable for cancellation of admission.
- 6) Provided further that this refund rule is concurrent with the rules and guidelines of other professional statutory bodies appointed for admission for relevant courses.

NOTE :-

1. Student should submit self-attested zerox copy of their PASS BOOK

- 2. Refundable deposits if **NOT CLAIMED** by the concerned student within **ONE CALENDER YEAR** from the date on which he / she ceases to be on the roll of the college, **WILL LAPSE IPSO-FACTO**
- 3. Deposits will not be refunded, if dues to the college, are not cleared by the student, on account of breakage of laboratory equipment, damage done to any college property, loss of liability books, etc.

Refund of Fees will be made only by RTGS into Student's Account.




