

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


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
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* संपादकीय *

Academic Library is the gateway to knowledge, providing a basic condition for lifelong learning, independent decision-making, and academic development of the students and the faculty. The academic libraries are always required to make them capable by acquiring various soft skills for managing constant technological changes and responding to the constantly changing end-user expectations.

National Educational Policy 2020 (NEP) intended to focus on the Library as an essential service in the context of the Schools / Colleges / University systems in India. The services provided by the Libraries present a set of advantages to play the most significant role in study, research, education and skill development.

We have a regular practice to organize 'Orientation Programme' for students and staff to guide to make best use of the library facilities as well providing information regarding to make use the OPAC (Online Public Access Catalogue), m-OPAC, arrangements of the books on the shelves and library rules.

The library is open from 7.00 a.m. to 6.00 p.m. on all working days. We are following 'Open Access System' with different subject sections are well-displayed. This encouraged our patrons to make the maximum use of the library resources and reading room. The library is equipped with internet facility. The library has an internet leased line with the speed of 25 MBPS. Cleanliness and maintenance of the library is always our top priority.

Total amount of Rs.3,48,993/- (Rupees Three Lac Forty-Eight Thousand Nine Hundred Ninety-Three Only) expended on reading materials i.e. text books, reference books, journals, newspapers...etc added during the year.

College is also purchasing seventeen daily newspapers for faculty and students. These newspapers are kept in the Reading Hall for students and in staff common room for faculty Under Student Welfare & Meritorious Students Book Bank Scheme 2986 text books were issued to 183 Participants from various classes.

The SOUL m-OPAC is a companion mobile application for Library automation software SOUL 3.0 which displays consolidated bibliographic data of the library. This application will work after configuration of the web OPAC URL of the respective institution who has already procured SOUL 3.0. It provides the search functionalities (simple and advanced) to get the list of items. It allows users with their mobile device. The Mobile Interface of OPAC lets our patrons access the library anytime, anywhere. It supports meeting patrons' expectations with robust features common to apps they use every day.




FIRST TRIBAL WOMAN PRESIDENT


On December 8, 2022, Netflix made the movie available for streaming worldwide. And at the Oscars 2023, it was named Best Documentary Short Film.

(खर सांगू आम्ही महराष्ट्रीयन त्या कच्छभूमीचे शतशः ऋणी आहोत जिने ह्या थोर माणसाला महाराष्ट्रात पाठवलं. हा थोर डॉ. नानजीभाईंनी जन्मभूमी कच्छ बरोबर, कर्मभूमी महाराष्ट्राच नांव संपूर्ण जगात पसरवून जन्म आणि कर्म भूमीला धन्य केलं.)ईश्वराचा वरदहस्तच डॉ. नानजीभाईंवर होता म्हणून नानजीचा डॉ. नानजीभाई बनवण्यास वेळ लागला नाही. अनेक दुकाने, अनेक धर्मशाळा, अनेक सामाजिक संस्था, एकातून अनेकात रुपांतर करुन नानजीभाईंनी देशातील नव्हेतर परदेशातील सरकारला, श्रीलंकेतील सरकारला पी.एच.डी. देण्यास भाग पाडून डॉक्टरेट किताब मिळवला. चौथीपर्यंत शिकलेली व्यक्ती डॉक्टरेट किताब मिळवू शकते यातच त्यांच्या सर्व कार्याचा आढावा येतो

डॉ. नानजीभाई खिमजीभाई ठक्कर ठाणावाला यांच्या समाजाच्या दिन दुबळ्यांना, गरजूंना, पिडीतांबरोबर, धर्मकार्याला, शिक्षणकार्याला, समाजकार्याला मदत करण्यासाठी या ट्रस्टच्या माध्यमातून भारतातील छोट्यातल्या छोट्या गावात व मोठ्यातल्या मोठ्या शहरात

समाजकार्य करीत असतात, गोर गरिबांचे आधार बनतात, धर्माचे रक्षक बनतात. एवढेच नव्हे तर ते परदेशातही समाजकार्य करीत असतात.

आध्यात्मिकतेला डॉ. नानजीभाई यांनी आपल्या जीवनात प्रथम स्थान दिले आहे. आज वयाच्या ६४ व्या वर्षात पदार्पण करताना त्यांची स्फुर्ती, शक्ती आणि गरीबांसाठी २४ तास आणि ३६५ दिवस काम करताना ते कधीच थकलेले दिसत नाहीत. आजच्या तरुणाला लाजवतील अशा पद्धतीची त्यांची स्फुर्ती आहे. ते नेहमी त्याचं वय ४० च सांगतात कारण अजुनही त्यांच्यात ४० ची उमेद आहे. आजही ते त्याचं जोमाने कार्य करीत असतात. परंतु त्यांच्या वयाच्या ४०तील काम भवितव्यासाठी होतं परंतु आताच काम मात्र ते लोकाच्या, समाजाच्या, धर्माच्या, शिक्षणाच्या सर्व बाबीच्या भवितव्यासाठी आहे.

डॉ. नानजीभाई. त्यांनी कित्येक शिक्षण संस्था उभारुन, कित्येक शिक्षण संस्थेला मदत करुन व्यक्त केली. यावेळेस मला एक सांगावसे वाटतं. शिक्षण महर्षि म्हणतात आज समाजाला शिक्षणाची गरज आहे. मुलांना शिक्षण द्या आणि त्याबरोबर संस्काराचेही बाळकडू पाजा. मुलींना सर्व प्रथम शिकवा ती चार कुळाचा उद्दार करते हे विसरु नका.

शिक्षणाबरोबर डॉ. नानजीभाईंनी लोकांच्या आरोग्याकडे लक्ष पुरविले आहे. ते म्हणतात, आजार व्यक्तीकडे पाहुन येत नाही. त्यांच्यात कसलाही भेदभाव नाही. आजार कधीच श्रीमंत व गरीब असा भेदभाव करीत नाही. जाऊ दे बिचारा गरीब आहे उपचारासाठी पैसे खर्च करु शकणार नाही असे म्हणून सोडून देत नाही. त्यामुळे मानवी शरीराला निरोगी ठेवण्यासाठी अनेक प्रकारची शिबीरे आयोजित केलेली आहेत. शिवाय अनेक हॉस्पीटल्सची निर्मिती केली. एवढेच नव्हे तर ते म्हणतात देवाच्या दरबारात माणूस आणि प्राणी सारखा आहे. प्रत्येक सजीवात देव आहे. म्हणून त्यांनी प्राणीमात्रांवर उपचार करता यावा म्हणून प्राण्यांसाठी मोफत रुग्णालय काढले असून गावातील कोणत्याही भागात प्राणी आजारी असेल तर फोन येताच ॲम्बुलन्स पाठवून त्या प्राण्याची सेवा करण्यासाठी रुग्णालयात आनतात. गोरगरिबांना विनामुल्य औषधे, नविन होणाऱ्या डॉक्टर्सना आर्थिक मदत देत असतात.

यांच्याकडे येणारा प्रत्येक माणूस जात, धर्म, पथ हा भेदभाव विसरुन येतो. नानजीभाई रघुवंशाचे असले तरी त्यांनी मस्जीद, गिरीजा घरांना सुद्धा मदत केली आहे. त्यांनी त्यांच्या जीवनात माणसाला, माणसातील माणुसकीला महत्व दिले आहे हे स्पष्ट होते.

आळंदी येथे इंद्रायणीच्या काठावर ३ १कोटी रुपये खर्च करुन मंदिर बांधत आहे.

नानजीभाई समाजातील विकलांग व्याक्तिंकडे पाहतानासुद्धा त्याच्यातील ईश्वराकडे पाहतात आणि ईश्वरसेवा म्हणून त्या व्यक्तीला मदत करीत असतात. आजपर्यंत कित्येक विकलांग व्यक्तींना व्हिल चेअर, कृत्रीमपाय, दूरध्वनी बुथ देऊन त्यांना सक्षम बनवले आहे.

माणसाच्या मुलभूत गरजा प्रत्येक सजीव प्राण्याच्या दृष्टीने अत्यंत महत्वाच्या आहेत. आणि डॉ. नानजीभाई त्यांच्या या गरजांना ओळखून अनेक गावात (मुरबाड तालुक्यात तर २९) कुपनलिका बांधत्या.

डॉ. नानजीभाई यांनी कैद्यासाठीही विशेष कार्य केले आहे. त्यांच्यासाठी अनेक शिबीरे भरवून त्यांना भविष्यात उत्तम जीवन जगता यावे यासाठी प्रयत्न करीत असतात.

निराधारांना, विधवा महिलांना, ज्यांना कोणीच नाही अशांना ते स्वत:चे रेशन कार्ड देतात. त्यावर त्यांचे पोट भरेल एवढे मोफत धान्य देतात.

खरं सांगू असे कितीही पाने लिहीत गेलो तरी डॉ नानजीभाईंच कार्य संपणार नाही. त्यांच्या या कार्याची समाजातील सर्व थरातील लोकांनी, सरकारनी घेतली असून त्यांना अनेक क्षेत्रात अनेक पुरस्कारांनी सन्मानित केले आहे. जे पुरस्कार नानजीभाईंना मिळाले असतील त्या पुरस्काराने नानजीभाईंच नांव किती मोठे झाले हे मला माहीत नाही. परंतू त्या पुरस्कार देणाऱ्या संस्थेचे आणि त्या पुरस्काराचे महत्व मात्र नक्कीच वाढले आहे.

सर्वात महत्वाचे म्हणजे नानजीभाई कडून सर्वांना काही ना काही शिकायला नक्कीच मिळतं. राजकीय पुढारी, सरकारी नोकर यांच्या पासून एक गोष्ट नक्की शिकावी. ती म्हणजे त्यांच्या कार्यालयात लोकांच्या समस्या सोडवण्याचा प्रकार. ते सर्वासमोर प्रत्येकाशी बोलत असतात. कोणतीही गोष्ट कुणापासून लपवून ठेवत नाहीत. हो किंवा नाही फक्त दोनच उत्तर देतात.

आसे या डॉ. नानजीभाई खिमजीभाई ठक्कर हे २३ सप्टेंबर २०२३ रोजी ७८ व्या वर्षात पदार्पण करीत आहेत त्यांच्या वाढिदवसानिमित्त त्यांच्या तमाम चाहत्याकडून हार्दिक शुभेच्छा. डॉ. नानजीभाई यांना उदंड आयुष्य लाभो. असे म्हणताना डॉ. नानजीभाईंचेच एक वाक्य लिहावसे वाटते 'इन्सान को अपनी आयु बढानेका और घटानेका भगवान ने मंत्र दिया है। जो अच्छा कर्म करता है उसका आयु जरुर बढता है। और जो बुरे कर्म करता है उसकी आयु जरुर घटती है' नानजीभाईच्या याच वाक्याचा आधार घेत आज समाजातील वाईट कृत्य करणाऱ्यांचे आयुष्य कमी होवो आणि आमच्या नानजीभाईंच आयुष्य उदंड वाढो जेणे करुन आजच्या समाजाला एक आधार मिळेल, एवढेच. पुन्हा एकदा वाढिदवसाच्या हार्दिक शुभेच्छा!
