## Scholarship Schemes by Central Government

### I) Post Matric Scholarships Scheme for Minorities

- 1) Students belonging to six notified minority communities viz. Muslim, Christian, Sikh, Buddhist, Jain, Parsi (Zoroastrian) studying in India
- 2) Applicant must be a resident/domicile of Maharashtra
- 3) Student must have secured not less than 50% marks or equivalent grade in the previous final examination.
- 4) The annual income of parents/guardians from all sources **does not exceed Rs.2.00 lakh**

### II) Central Sector Scheme of Scholarships for College and University Students

- 1) Students who are above 80th percentile of successful candidates in the relevant stream from a particular Board of Examination in Class XII. The list is available on [www.dh pune.gov.in](http://www.dh pune.gov.in) website
- 2) Having family income of less than Rs.8 lakh per annum

### III) Post-matric Scholarship for Students with Disabilities

- 1) The scholarship is applicable to students with disabilities with 40% and above and having a valid certificate of disability as prescribed under the rules issued by the competent authority
- 2) The annual income of parents/guardians from all sources **does not exceed Rs.2.50 lakh.**

## Scholarship Scheme by University of Mumbai

### Financial Assistance to Needy and Financially Backward Class Students

Only 5 students having good academic record, annual income not more than Rs.1,00,000/- and age not more than 25 years are eligible for the said scheme.

## Scholarship Schemes by Other Bodies/Institutions/Organizations

### Association of Non-Government Colleges, Mumbai (ANGC)

- 1) Scholarship will be given to only those students who are not availing any other scholarship / freeship.
- 2) Preference will be given to girl students.
- 3) Scholarship is meant for students who are economically backward and deserving.

### For all the schemes:

Aadhar Mobile number linking, Bank Aadhar Linking, Domicile Certificate, Income Certificate is must.

More than 75% attendance is compulsory.
