**POST MATRIC SCHOLARSHIP SCHEME FOR MINORITIES 2021-22
(Government of India – Ministry of Minority Affairs)**

Students belonging to six notified minority communities viz. Muslim, Christian, Sikh, Buddhist, Jain, Parsi (Zoroastrian) studying in India and fulfilling the Scheme guidelines are eligible to apply for **Post Matric Scholarship Scheme for Minorities 2021-22**. The Post Matric Scholarship Scheme is online Scheme and one can apply for fresh or renewal Scholarship under this Scheme on the National Scholarship Portal (NSP) at <https://scholarships.gov.in>. Link to the Portal is also provided on the website of the Ministry of Minority Affairs, i.e. www.minorityaffairs.gov.in. The last date for applying online is **31/12/2021**. Under any circumstances, offline forms will not be accepted. The sanctioned amount of scholarship (Course/tuition fee and maintenance allowance) will be directly transferred by the Central Government to Aadhar linked Bank Account (Under DBT Mode) of the student.

Eligibility & Conditions :

- 1) Applicant must be a resident/domicile of Maharashtra.
- 2) Scholarship will be awarded to the students who have passed in the previous final examination.
- 3) The annual income of parents/guardians from all sources does not exceed Rs.2.00 lakh.
- 4) A student shall be eligible for only one scholarship out of all the available Scholarships of Central/State Government meant for SC/ST/OBC/ minority.
- 5) The continuance of award (for Renewal applicants) will be subject to securing 50% marks in the previous year's examination (provided the students pursues the same course and same Institute/School).
- 6) Scholarship will not be given to more than two students from a family.
- 7) If a student is found to have obtained a scholarship by false statement, his/her scholarship will be cancelled forthwith and the amount of the scholarship paid will be recovered from the student.
- 8) Students should be regular in attendance for which the yardstick will be decided by the competent authority of the college.


Essential documents required :

- 1) Student Photo
- 2) Institute Verification Form
- 3) Residential/Domicile Certificate
- 4) An Income Certificate, issued from a Competent Authority in the State/UT Governments is required in respect of parent/guardian of the student.
- 5) A Self-Certified Community Certificate is required from the student who has attained 18 years of age. For others the Community Certificate certified by parent/guardian of the student is required.
- 6) Attested Mark Sheet, indicating that the applicant has secured not less than 50% marks in the last qualifying exam at higher secondary/ graduation level.
- 7) Fee Receipt of 'Current Course Year'.
- 8) Xerox copy of Adhar linked Bank Account number of the Student along with the IFSC Code of the bank branch
- 9) Aadhaar number of the student and if Aadhaar is not available then bonafide student certificate from the school/institute and scanned copies of bank passbook and Aadhaar enrolment ID (if applied for Aadhaar).
- 10) Attested copy of Ration Card & Leaving Certificate

Procedure for Applying (Fresh and Renewal) :

- 1) The scheme is implemented through the National Scholarship Portal (NSP). It is mandatory for all students to apply online on the website i.e. www.scholarships.gov.in.
- 2) Before applying online; the students are asked to go through the detailed instructions for filling in online application and 'Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)' on the National Scholarship Portal Homepage.
- 3) The Applicant can contact college office for resolving the problem while filling the online form.
- 4) The scholarship, once awarded, may be renewed during the next academic year of the course on the production of certificate that the student has secured 50% marks in the previous year's examination (provided the students pursues the same course and same Institute/School).
- 5) After filling the online form, the applicant is required to take a print out of the online form and submit it in the college office for further process with the relevant necessary documents as mentioned above **on or before 31/12/2021**.
