## Sheth T.J. Education Society's Sheth N.K.T.T. College of Commerce & Sheth J.T.T. College of Arts, Thane (Autonomous)

(Affiliated to University of Mumbai)

The College has been granted autonomous status by the UGC from the year 2024-25.

With this status college can start /select new programs/Courses (subjects) and restructure the examination system.

Examination will be conducted by the College for all programs and classes in internal (40 percent) and external (60 percent) pattern.

**DEGREE WOULD BE AWARDED BY UNIVERSITY OF MUMBAI** as college is continued to be affiliated to University of Mumbai.

Along with autonomy, college is all set to implement NEP (National Education Policy 2020) from 2024-25 for all first year classes with its own syllabus and examination pattern.

NEP offers and promotes a multidisciplinary approach to education, encouraging students to choose subjects across different disciplines and bridging the gap between arts, science and humanities.

Each semester will be of 22 credits, where 1-credit= 15 lectures. Subjects will be of 2 credits (50 marks) and 4 credits (100 marks).

Distribution of Credits would be in six verticals as follows:

- i. **Major (Core) Subject comprising Mandatory and Elective Courses:** There will be 2 major subjects, one in each semester of 4 credits from FY.
- ii. Minor subject: There will be one Minor subject in FY from SEM-II related to stream

## DEGREE WOULD BE OFFERED IN MAJOR AND MINOR SUBJECTS.

- iii. Generic/ Open Elective Courses (OE)- It will be offered in FY and SY. OE is to be chosen compulsorily from faculty other than that of the Major. Different subjects will be offered in OE in FY and SY. It will be offered in Semester I, II, III and IV.
- iv. Vocational and Skill Enhancement Courses (VSC & ESC)
  - Vocational Skill Courses (VSC): It will include 'Hands on Training' corresponding to Major subject and will be offered in FY, SY and TY. VSC will be offered in Semester I, II, III and V.
  - Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC): It will be offered in FY and SY. SEC will be offered in Semester I, II and IV.

## v. Ability Enhancement Courses (AEC), Indian Knowledge System (IKS) and Value Education Courses (VEC):

- *AEC*: The focus of this course will be on development of linguistic and communication skills. AEC will be offered in Semester I, II, III and IV.
- IKS: It will be offered in FY. It offers knowledge about ancient Indian Knowledge. Generic IKS will be offered in Semester I.
- VEC: It will be offered in FY. The focus will be on Understanding India, Environmental Science/Education, and Digital and Technological Solutions. VEC will be offered in Semester I and II.
- vi. OJT (on job training)/Field Projects/ Internship/ Apprenticeship/ Community Engagement and Service corresponding to the Major (Core) Subject, Co-curricular Courses (CC) and Research Project Internship/Apprenticeship corresponding to the Major (Core) Subject:

OJT/Field Projects/Community Engagement and Service corresponding to the Major (Core) Subject will be offered in SY and TY. It will be offered in Semester III and V. Co-curricular Courses (CC) such as Health and Wellness, Yoga education sports, and fitness, Cultural Activities, NSS/NCC and Fine/ Applied/ Visual/ Performing Arts will be offered in I and/or II year. CC will be offered in Semester I, II, III and IV.

• Research Projects will be offered in the fourth year for 4-year Honours/Research Degree.
