Open Access to Library Shelves – Reference Collection



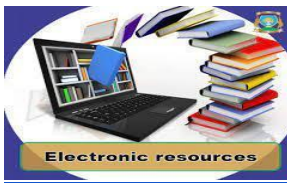

Guideline to Search

- Online Catalogue of the library collections, books, journals, magazines and other materials is accessible online 24x7. One can know the list of books with the details of author, title, subject as well account status.
- OPAC is an existing aspect of library automation. As it is an online catalogue it reflects the database available online with the help of a network while Web-OPAC reflects the database worldwide to the user using internet facilities. The resources of the library have been computerized with integrated library management software – SOUL 3.0 ILMs.
- The SOUL m-OPAC is a companion mobile application for Library automation software SOUL 3.0 which displays consolidated bibliographic data of the library. This application will work after

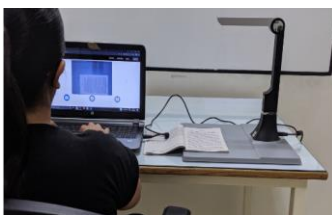
- Newly arrived books are displayed on the stand installed at the entrance of the library and are displayed for a week. It will be issued only after a week of display.

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Reprographic Services



Reprography, as explained, is a term that is now used in place of photo duplicating, photocopying, duplicating, printing, document reproduction or documentary reproduction. Library users have easy access to photocopying facilities, enabling them to reproduce required material from books and journals.
