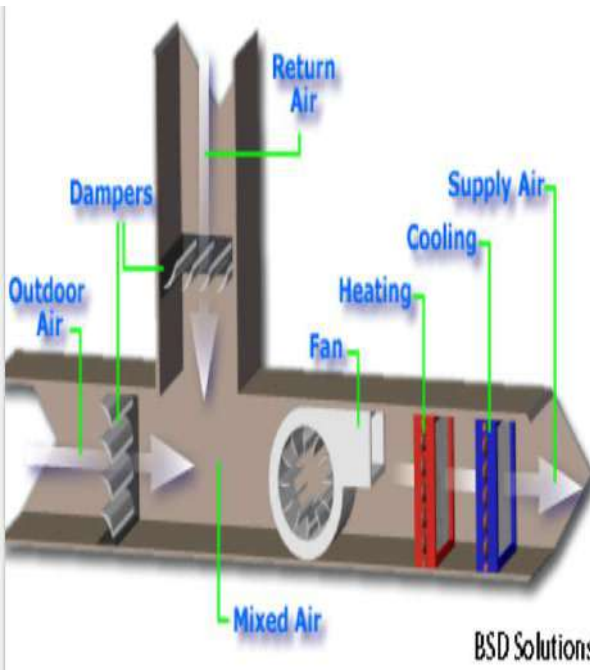

### Economizers

- Nature, winter provides an opportunity to enhance the cooling system by using the cold outside air to cool things down.
- An economizer is a mechanical device that reduces the amount of energy used to cool a data center or other buildings. It is integrated into the building's heating, ventilation and air conditioning (HVAC) systems, which is why it is sometimes called a HVAC economizer. An economizer uses outside air to help control indoor temperatures and achieve greater energy efficiency.
- But it isn't as simple as opening a window to accomplish this. To do so, you need to employ what is called an economizer.
- There are two types: air-side economizers and waterside economizer



### Optimizing Airflow

#### Optimize airflow Distribution

- Exchange of air is important. To bring the precise cooling environment, air must be exchanged at a sufficient rate. In high-density data centers, air has to be exchanged 50 times an hour. If sufficient air is not exchanged, cooling air will heat up before it reaches the equipment and disaster could occur. Optimizing airflow reduces cooling costs. It helps minimize costs without you having to buy the newest product. That can help optimize the airflow around servers and other networking equipment.
