Annual Report:2023-24

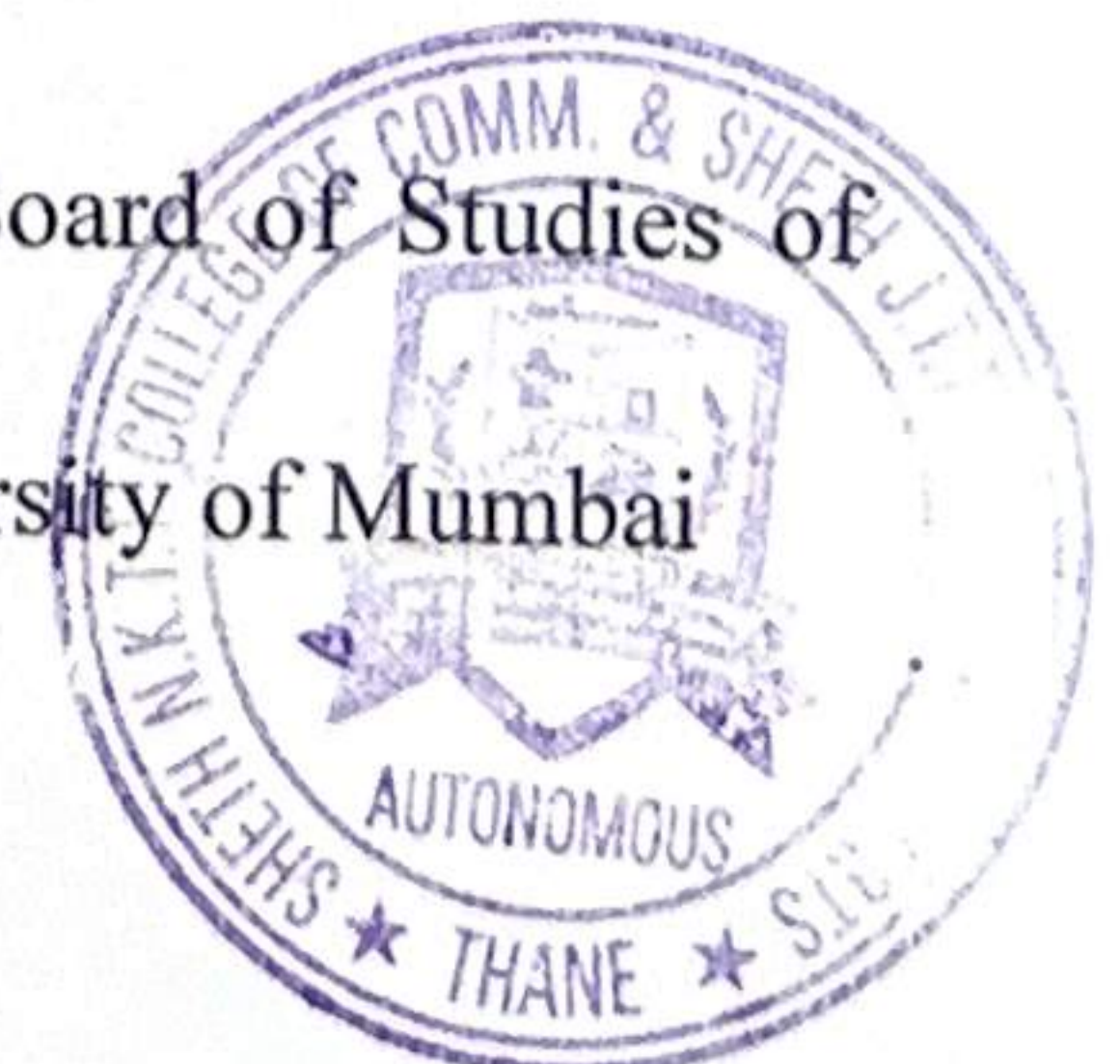

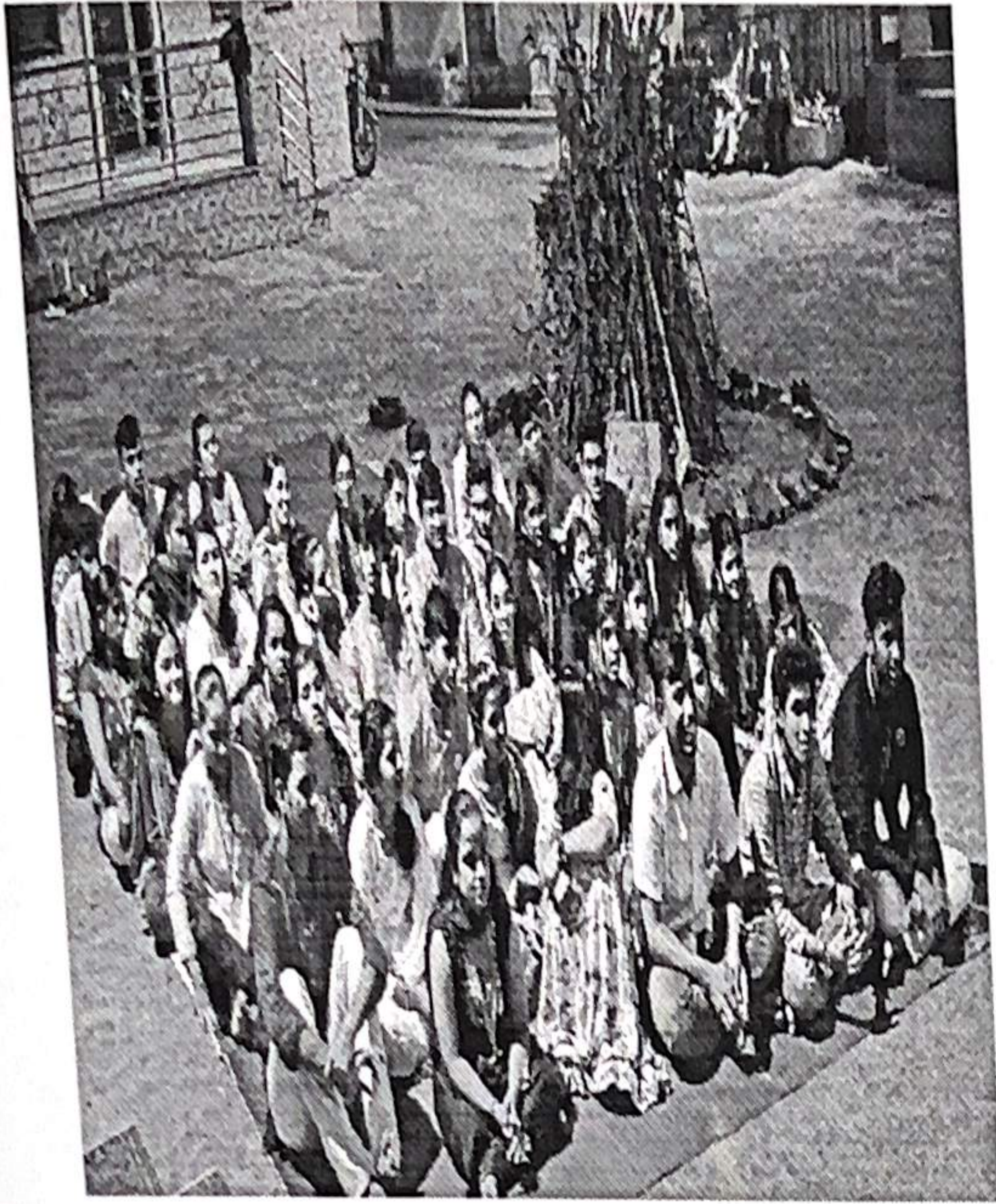

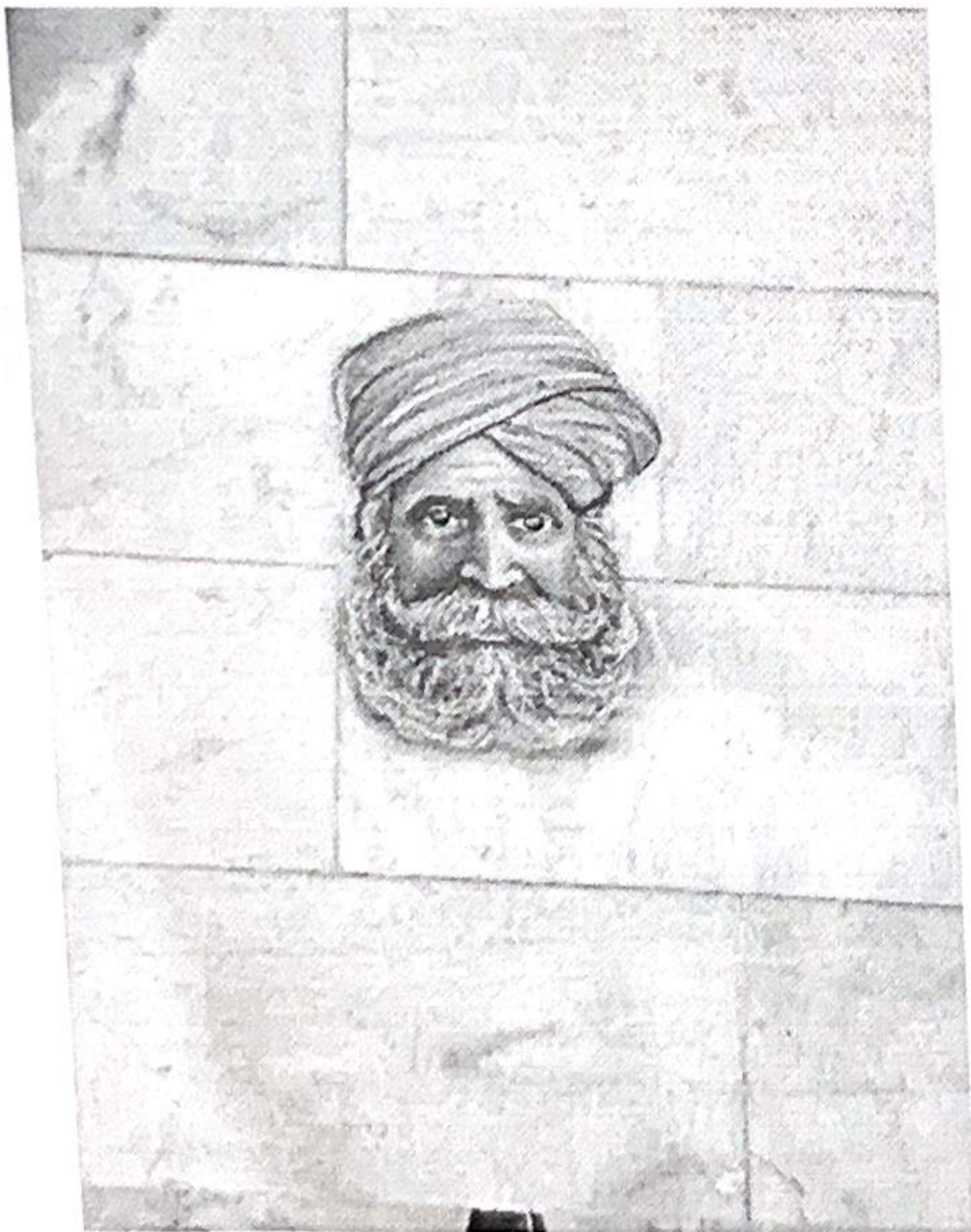
