Report of Student Satisfaction Survey (sample) 2021-22

The online student satisfaction survey (sample) was conducted from 8th April, 2022 to 29th May, 2022. In this survey 795 students participated.


The findings of this survey are as follows,


- 1. Syllabus completion:** 45.7 % responded 100% completed, 31.8% responded 84% completed and remaining responded below 69% completed.
- 2. Preparation of teachers for the classes:** 39.1% responded thoroughly, 57% responded satisfactorily and remaining below poorly.
- 3. Communication of teachers:** 66.4% responded always effective, 23.3% responded sometimes effective and remaining below just satisfactory.
- 4. Teachers approach to teaching:** 42.1% responded excellent, 39.5% responded very good, 15.7% good and remaining below fair.
- 5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers:** 61.9% always fair, 31.2% usually fair and remaining below sometimes unfair.
- 6. Discussion of performance of students in assignments:** 58.6% every time, 26.7% usually, 11.3% occasionally and remaining below rarely.
- 7. Promotion of students for internship, student exchange and field visit by the institute:** 46% regularly, 30.2% often, 14.1% sometimes and remaining below rarely.
- 8. The teaching and mentoring process facilitates cognitive, social and emotional growth of students:** 32.8% significantly, 53.3% very well, 9.9% moderately and remaining below marginally.
- 9. The institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow. (eg. Activities Gymkhana, Art Circle, NSS, DLLE, WDC and Other Committee):** 50.9% strongly agree, 38.4% agree and remaining below neutral.
- 10. Teachers inform you about your expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes:** 59.1% every time, 30.4% usually and remaining below occasionally.
- 11. Your mentor does a necessary follow-up with an assigned task to you:** 58.4% every time, 29.6% usually and remaining below occasionally.
- 12. The teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications (Such as Case Study, Role Play, Real Life Examples, Presentations etc):** 61.5% every time, 27.7% usually and remaining below occasionally.


13. The teachers identify your strengths and encourage you with providing the right level of challenge: 50.2% fully, 33.8% reasonably and remaining below partially.
14. Teachers are able to identify your weaknesses and help you to overcome them: 44.4% every time, 34.3% usually, 17.7% occasionally and remaining below rarely.
15. The institution makes an effort to engage students in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process: 37.9% strongly agree, 47.3% agree, 11.8% neutral and remaining below disagree.
16. The institute/ teachers use student centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences: 41.1% to a great extent, 45.2% moderate and remaining below somewhat.
17. Teachers encourage you to participate in extracurricular activities: 49.2% strongly agree, 42.3% agree, and remaining below neutral.
18. Efforts are made by the institute/ teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make you ready for the world of work: 45.8% to a great extent, 41% moderate, and remaining below somewhat.
19. Percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia, etc. while teaching: 30.3% above 90%, 31.1% -70 to 89%, 20.3%- 50 to 69% and remaining below 49%.
20. The overall quality of the teaching-learning process in your institute is very good: 44.4% strongly agree, 44.2% agree, 9.9% neutral and remaining below disagree.
21. Give three observation / suggestions to improve the overall teaching learning experience in your institution:
