NSS ACTIVITY REPORT

INTERNATIONAL DAY AGAINST DRUG ABUSE AND ILLICIT TRAFFICKING

NSS UNIT of Sheth T.J. Education Society's Sheth N.K.T.T. College of Commerce & Sheth J.T.T. College of Arts in association with Anti – Narcotics Cell, Thane organised Workshop on Wednesday, 26 June 2024 on the occasion of **International Day against Drug Abuse and Illicit Trafficking**. The objective of the session is to '**protect the youth from the bad influence of drugs**'. Session was conducted covering topics ill effects of consumption of drugs, De-addiction, saving the youth from the grasps of drugs and helping the police with tackling the trafficking of drugs. Samajratna Dr. Sheth Nanjibhai Khimjibhai Thakkar Thanawala, President of T.J. Education Society emphasised students to avoid consumption of drugs or narcotics substance.

Deputy Commissioner of Police, Crime Branch, Thane Mr. Shivraj Patil, spoke about the bad influence and ill effects of drugs, actions taken by the police against drug users, peddlers and repeated offenders. Various initiatives undertaken by the Anti – narcotics cells for the citizens, de-addictions centres, volunteering by the students for such initiatives were also emphasised.

Dr. Dilip Patil, Principal Sheth NKTT College explained the importance of drug free society and its impact on youth and urged the students to stay away from consumption of drugs. Vice Principal Dr. Manoshi Bagchi, NSS Program Officers Ms. Dipali Mulmulay and Mr. Vibhav Galadagekar also actively participated in the workshop. **358** students (**146** Male & **212** Female) attended the session.

After the session, NSS volunteers organised a de-addiction rally with objective to create awareness regarding drug free society. The rally was flagged off by Hon' Commission of Police, Thane, Mr. Ashutosh Dumbare. 87 NSS volunteers participated in the rally.
